**WHEN:** Labor Day -- Monday, September 6, 2010

**2 Locations to Choose From**

① **SHADES BEACH:** *Rides start & finish at Shades Beach, 7000 E. Lake Rd. (Rt. 5) at Bartlett Rd.*

**DISTANCES:** 25 km - Predominately flat & fun for all ages!  
50 km - Slightly hillier with scenic views of Lake Erie!  
100 km - A more challenging ride! (Beautiful scenery, bigger hills)  
50 mi. - Our famous *Flat Fifty!*

② **ALBION:** *Rides start & finish at the Albion Borough Park (Fairgrounds). N. Main St. off Route 6N in Albion*

**DISTANCES:** 25 km - Flat to rolling terrain through countryside surrounding Conneaut Creek!  
50 km - Rolling terrain with one challenging climb through scenic Amish farms!  
100 km - More Amish Country with more hills and more fun!  
Children's Riding Area – laps on 1/3 mile loop with adult – for all ages!

**Entrants under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a responsible cycling adult.**
